- We contemplated the National Park of Timanfaya. We tried some experiences and we saw the Geisiers and the “natural” klin.

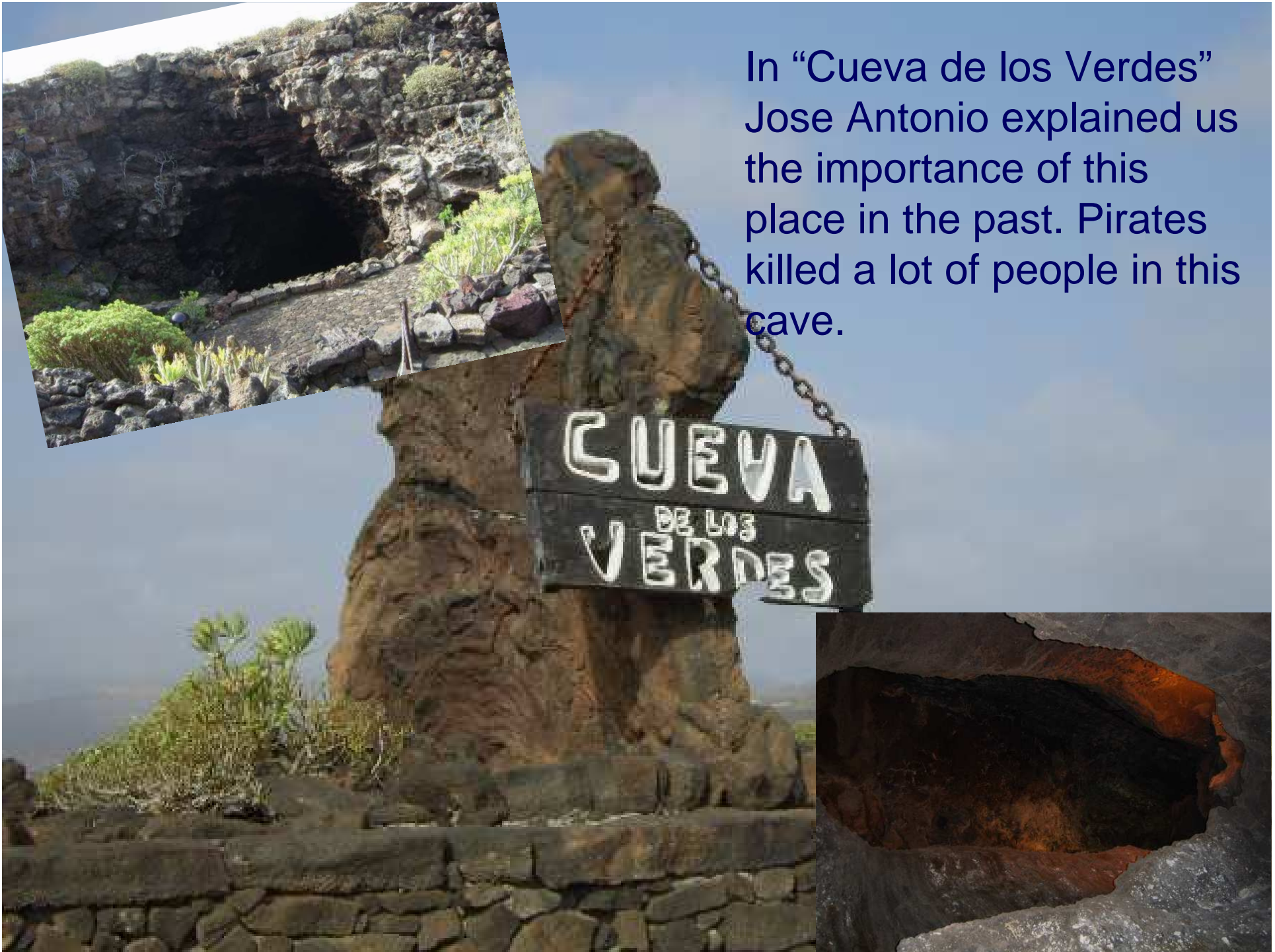


Monumento del campesino & trek around the aula
